The word nostalgia derives from a morbid longing to return to one's home or native country. At one point in the 19th century, it was even classified as a disease, used to describe "intense homesickness experienced by sailors, convicts, or African slaves. Although nostalgia is strongly related to a sense of displacement, it is not limited to (physical) space and has recently often been associated with the context of shared emotions. In "Past Future Tense," Revaleka reflects on the nature of nostalgia not only as a yearning for the past but also seeing how it might influence our present and future. His work in this exhibition examines the malleability of our own memories, specifically how nostalgia seems to have an emotional grip on our lives.

Revaleka's new body of work incorporates his personal experiences and forgotten moments that appear to seep into our past as the viewers, forming an intimate but universal history. Looking back on the past often comes in the form of remembering, but the further time flies, the more our mind starts to have difficulties in gathering the fragments of what precisely happened and how we felt back then. Instead of lingering and stuck trying to piece together these intricate puzzles, can we use the past as a source of reflection for the future?
