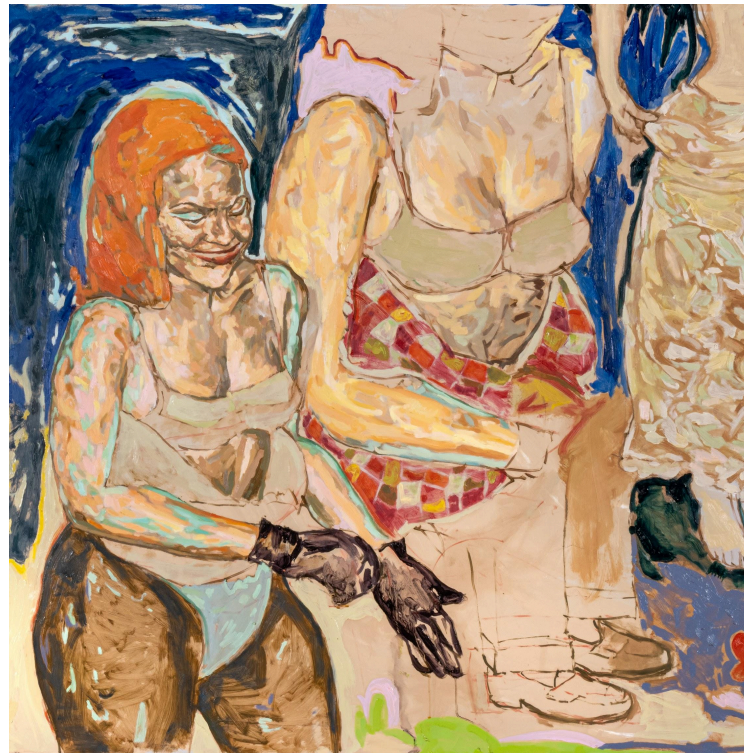

STEM Projects dengan bangga mempersembahkan *Desember Musim Hujan Ada Sedikit Cerah Yang Menyenangkan – December's Rainy Season (A Bit Bright Blue Sky) Fawned Upon by Me*, presentasi tunggal pertama Pandu Wijaya (l. 2001, Indonesia) dengan galeri. This presentation invites audiences into an absurd world inspired by digital culture, showcased through 23 oil paintings on canvas.

Deeply connected to the daily life of his generation, Pandu's works reflect a fragmented rhythm influenced by the digital realm. The figures in these paintings appear to mirror memes—a digital cultural medium that compresses complex ideas into absurd, visually humorous forms.

Pandu's creative process results from a structured routine, where spontaneity becomes an essential element he cultivates through daily technical practice and the refinement of ideas. Works such as *The Prediction of a Competition*, *I Can't Sleep*, *I Miss My Dog*, and *Milo's Bath* feature humor intertwined with emotional depth. In other paintings, Pandu also engages with and studies the history of Western art, as seen in *After Robert de Cévrieux* and *Orphan Girl in a Cemetery*, inspired by John Singer Sargent.

Pandu Wijaya's first solo presentation, *December's Rainy Season (A Bit Bright Blue Sky) Fawned Upon by Me*, serves as a metaphor for the everyday experiences of life. The subjects Pandu presents in his works seem to suggest that within absurdity, there is always space to accept that ambiguity is a fundamental part of the human experience.

December's Rainy Season (A Bit Bright Blue Sky) Fawned Upon by Me will be open to the public from December 21, 2024 – February 9, 2025. Gallery hours are Tuesday – Friday, 12:00 PM – 7:00 PM, and Saturday & Sunday, 12:00 PM – 8:00 PM, with the exhibition opening on Friday, December 20, 2024, at 4:00 PM at Tirtodipuran Link Building A, Yogyakarta.

Pandu Wijaya

Pandu Wijaya (b. 2001, Surakarta) began to notice how interesting painting was from his childhood, especially after experiencing a documentary biography of a Renaissance artist. The classic visual elements from that era became the starting point for his love of painting. His interest in classic visual elements influenced his tastes and the rhythm of his artistic work, which is now more closely aligned with the atmosphere of spending time in the studio. Work patterns that require basic study points influence him and become his inspiration for producing work. Fragments in the studio, such as sketches, notes, preparatory drawings, and leftover color palettes that have not yet been cleaned up, become intriguing artistic subjects for exploration. He chose to pursue this because the studio is a kind of sacred ground—a pleasant place to work.

With an artist-focused approach at our core, we intend to create a platform that enables artists to gain the necessary level of support in the early stage of their careers, while encouraging them to explore their practices and create new works.
