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Hudan Seltan ponders the delicate and sometimes invisible balance between isolation and connection in a world dominated by ever-evolving digital communication and social dynamics. The exhibition captures a glimpse of the life of young people today in familiar moments and settings. These social situations shape Hudan's work in this exhibition, where he delves into the intimate and emotional complexity embedded within our relationship. The exhibition prompts a reflection on the paradox of our identity in society as opposed to how we want it to be, especially at the stage where we are still searching for ourselves.

Hudan's choice to depict the younger generation in an intimate, everyday setting can easily be attributed to his position as someone still experiencing that situation today, not just as an artist. His paintings depict daily situations young people experience—how they hang out, communicate, or banal activities that are often forgotten. Somehow, they can also remind us of how we lived our days when we were young. In a way, this exhibition might be selfish in the sense that it depicts the situation that is specifically experienced by the current generation. While the visual narrative mirrors the internal struggles of today's youth, the feeling of isolation within a community is not exclusive to just one generation. It is collectively shared. Some people might be luckier than others in never or rarely experiencing this awkwardness. But perhaps we can find a connection through this shared experience of unpleasantness.

Artist Bio

Hudan Seltan (b. 2000, Bukittinggi) is an artist and art student based in Yogyakarta. His work focuses on casual patterns and urban themes, where everyday contexts transform into extraordinary revelations. Exploring the human condition, Hudan's work weaves stories about alienation, absurdity, and the search for meaning. The everyday context in his work refers to using settings, objects, or situations that are ordinary and familiar. The scenes in his work highlight the beauty and importance of these moments and challenge preconceptions about what is worthy of artistic representation. The visual language he uses is usually an everyday scene that is specially arranged and composed, filled with many characters. Using brush strokes with manipulative colors, sometimes intense and sometimes soft or even cloudy. His work is presented in an unintentional and incomplete form, as an artistic decision that gives the impression that a story never ends while providing a touch of mystery.
